

Legal information

In the case of physician's suspicion or diagnosis of HIV infection or AIDS or positive result of the test for HIV, art. 27 and 29 of the Act of 5 December 2008 on prevention and control of infections and infectious diseases (consolidated text in Dz.U. of 2018, item 151), the physician and the Laboratory are obliged to report such fact to a competent district public health inspector.

In the above case, a person infected with HIV or suffering from AIDS is entitled to reserve the information sent in the report by filing a separate declaration.

The above mentioned report includes the following: first name and last name initials or password, age, sex, district in which the person resides, clinical diagnosis and mode of infection.

PATIENT'S DECLARATION **

Acting in accordance with art. 41, item 1 of the Act of 5 December 2008 on prevention and control of infections and infectious diseases (consolidated text in Dz.U. of 2018, item 151), I hereby declare that in the case of

- physician's suspicion or diagnosis of HIV infection or AIDS*
- positive result of the test for HIV*,

I reserve the following information allowing my identification, i.e., first and last name, date of birth, PESEL [personal id. number], citizenship, address.
